Kenmore State High School Percussion Equipment List



Kenmore SHS provides a variety of percussion instruments and mallets for the use of percussion students in the Instrumental Music program at Kenmore High.

In addition to the Instrumental and Vocal Music Fee, all percussion students are required to equip themselves with the following items, which will be utilised in home practice, and at school -

- Stick bag
- Drumsticks (Vic Firth brand, or Zildjian brand, model 5A sticks, with WOOD tip)
- Rubber mallets (Suggested brand and model Playwood M-02, or similiar)
- Yarn mallets (Suggested brand and model Playwood M-303, or similar)
- 8" Remo tunable practice pad
- Stand for tunable practice pad

Students who have already been learning percussion at primary school may already own some of the listed equipment, such as drumsticks and stick bag. They are welcome to use these at Kenmore SHS.

The approximate cost of all the above items is around \$250. The purchase of this equipment is a **once only** expense, as the students will use the equipment all through their years in the instrumental program. Although the equipment may be available from any good musical instrument store, *Just Percussion*, Creswell St Newstead is recommended as a reliable retailer. If you let the staff at *Just Percussion* know you are purchasing for a student of Kenmore SHS, they may be able to offer a small discount off the total purchase price.
