At Kenmore State High School (KSHS) we are proud to offer our students a broad range of resources to maximise every opportunity to excel at our school. To achieve great outcomes, and prepare our students for future pathways, KSHS provides many resources to assist with student learning. The size, complexity and range of programs on offer at the school places demands on resourcing and the Queensland Government supports children's education by providing funding for instruction (teachers), facilities (school grounds and buildings) and administration (staff to run the school). Funding to schools does not extend to individual student resources such as textbooks and online programs, equipment for personal use and many items used by students in the classroom.

Fees and charges detailed throughout this book are defined as State Education Fees, are categorised below and are transparently detailed throughout this booklet so that informed decisions may be made in relation to payment of the associated fees.

KSHS provides free instruction, administration and facilities to students enrolled at the school who are Australian citizens, permanent residents or children of Australian citizens or permanent residents.

KSHS charges for activities not associated with instruction, administration and facilities. Charges of fees to students may be for some of the following reasons but are not limited to these examples:

- Services, materials and consumables not defined as instruction, administration or facilities
- Educational services purchased from a provider other than KSHS
- Specialised education programs

Student Resource Scheme (SRS), Fees, and Charges



Parents are directly responsible for providing textbooks and other personal resources for their children whilst attending school. Kenmore SHS recognises that these costs can be high, and each year provides a Student Resource Scheme which is endorsed annually by the Parents & Citizens' Association. The scheme is a cost-effective alternative to purchasing textbooks and/or resources elsewhere, through reduced prices gained from the schools bulk purchasing practices. All parents are urged to support the scheme because without this support, we cannot provide the resources we believe we need to assure quality learning outcomes for all students.

The scheme is not used to raise funds for any other purpose than to provide resources for your child and administration of the scheme. Participation fees are directly applied to fund the services delivered by the scheme. The scheme provides the entire package for the specified participation fee and is not available in parts unless specifically discussed and approved by the Business Manager.

The SRS is applied to:

- Annual loan of textbooks, e-books and course materials in subjects as required (short term, long term and school usage).
- Access to class sets of books for short-term needs.
- Specially prepared workbooks or photocopies as required in subject areas.
- Access to innovative, new and different software resources (*Education Perfect/Atom*i).
- Student ID Card (including transport concession).
- Specialised materials, equipment and resources e.g. Art, Science, Industry, Physical Education, Film and Media, Vocational subjects – all of which must be of industry standard.

All students provide his/her own requisites as per the Year Level Stationery List requirements for 2026. These can be ordered online from early Term 4, 2024 with additional stationery that is required during the year available from the Bookshop at competitive prices.

What is provided by the Queensland Government?

The Queensland Government supports children's education by providing funding for instruction (teachers), facilities (school grounds and buildings) and administration (staff to run the school). Funding for the school does not extend to individual student resources such as textbooks (physical copy and e-books), equipment and the many items used by the student in the classroom. The SRS assists parent/caregivers to source these resources. Resources such as textbooks that will be used over time are hired to students to reduce the cost to families. Participating in the SRS also offers a convenient way for parent/caregivers to source the items that their child needs for school and ensures that all students have the same access to the same standard of resources. The types of resources that will be included are:

- **Owned** by the student e.g. The student ID Card, Diary/Planner and workbooks. Once provided these items are retained by the student.
- **Hired** to the student for a specific time e.g., textbooks/calculators, AV equipment and software. These items are to be returned to the school in a reasonable condition at the end of the hire period or if the student leaves the school.
- **Used in class** e.g., Stationery, timber, materials, consumables.

Detailed information on subject offered resources included in the SRS can be found in the Subject Requirements List located on page 8 (Year 7 -9), page 9 (Year 10), page 10 (Year 11 & 12).



The Fee

The school charges a flat fee for participating in the SRS. The fee for 2026 is \$365 endorsed by the School's Parents and Citizens Association. Every eligible student in Years 7 to 12 at Kenmore State High School receives financial assistance from Department of Education to offset the cost of textbooks and resources. This assistance is provided to the school once per year in the form of a Textbook and Resources Allowance (TRA). The school retains this allowance to offset the costs to the parents as detailed on page 8, 9 and 10.

The rate for 2026:

Years 7 to 10 - \$164.00 per student

Years 11 and 12 - \$357.00 per student

For students not participating in the SRS, a refund of the allowance will be paid, however all textbooks, resources and consumable costs as per the Subject Requirements List on pages 12-26 must be provided and paid by the parent.

Families can pay in instalments, and a recommended plan is outlined below:

- \$160 paid by Week 2 Term 1.
- \$105 paid by Week 2 Term 2; and
- \$100 paid by Week 2 Term 3.

Parents wishing to pay in instalments, or organise a different payment plan, must contact the Finance Office to set up a payment plan. Payment plans require a minimum deposit of \$100. All fees need to be finalised or a payment plan in place by 27 January 2026.

Participation Agreement Form (PAF)

If you choose to join the SRS, the Participation Agreement Form (PAF) in the enrolment booklet has been developed by the Department of Education and is used in all state schools. All parents/caregivers are required to complete this form. Participation is assumed for the duration of your child's enrolment unless you inform the school otherwise by completing a new Participation Agreement Form. Parents of participating students need to:

- **Complete and sign the SRS Agreement** (located in the *Enrolment Application Booklet*).
- Pay \$365 by one of the methods of payment listed on the next page by 27 January 2026.
- Pay a deposit and organise a payment plan with the school's Finance Manager. Please telephone (07) 3327 1503 to organise the plan no later than 27 January 2026.

Parents who choose NOT to participate in the SRS

Contribution to this scheme is voluntary. Parents/ Caregivers are under no obligation to join; however, parents/caregivers will need to provide all necessary textbooks, novels, software, and pay the school for resources that can't be individually sourced if they elect not to join the scheme. These items are listed from page 12-26 of this booklet.

Non-Payment of fees

The school operates the Student Resource Scheme to benefit all eligible students. It is not viable for the school to provide this service if fees are outstanding. It is for this reason that students may be refused entry into the scheme if fees are outstanding from the previous year/s.

Students with outstanding fees may be denied the opportunity to participate in non-compulsory school activities. Students will not be provided with resources until any outstanding fees from previous year/s have been paid.

Return of Resources

Repair or replacement costs will be charged for any items that are damaged or not returned.

Financial Difficulty

If you would like your child to participate in the SRS and are experiencing financial difficulties, please contact the school to discuss payment options. Any information that you provide will be treated as confidential.

Student Resource Scheme Refunds

The school will make a pro-rata refund to the parent of a student who (having paid the Student Resource Scheme fee) leaves the school during the year once a Student Clearance Form is completed. The pro-rata refund is calculated on the fees paid, less general levy items (including administration fee), the cost of consumed materials and the replacement cost of scheme items that are lost, negligently damaged, or not returned. It will also include the pro-rata Textbook and Resource Allowance for applicable students.

Choose Your Own Device (CYOD), Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)

At KSHS, technology is a tool that enhances pedagogy and allows differentiation in learning. Teachers as life-long learners, will continue to focus on developing their technological, pedagogical and content expertise, utilising ICT in an educationally purposeful way.

The school offers two models for student access to technology in the classroom and at home; A school managed Choose Your Own Device (CYOD) and a self-managed Bring Your Own Device (BYOD).

Access to the school Wi-fi is provided free of charge.

Vocational, Education and Training in Schools (VETiS) Funding

Government funding under the VETiS program enables each student to complete one free Certificate I or Certificate II VET course while at school. Most of our VET courses are eligible for VETiS funding, should families wish to use the funding for this purpose. Certificate III and higher courses are not eligible for VETiS funding and will attract course fees.

Families should consider carefully how they choose to use their VETiS funding as it can only be accessed once.

If a student chooses to enrol in multiple VET courses, parents may be required to pay course fees for the second and subsequent courses. In these instances, the school recommends that students apply for VETiS funding for the most expensive course and enrol in any other VET courses on a fee for service basis

Individual families are responsible for allocating their VETiS funding, through the RTO providing the course upon enrolment. Once used, VETiS funding will not be available for any other VET Certificate courses.

This includes courses offered by TAFE and external training providers.

GIEP - German Immersion Excellence Program

KSHS doesn't change additional fees to join our German Immersion Excellence Program, parents must agree to participate in the Student Resource Scheme due to the unique learning experiences, resources and artifacts.

KenX – Kenmore Excellence Program

Ken-X Excellence Program doesn't charge additional fees for the subject, but excursions and incursions providing exposure to innovative learning experiences and tools to solve real-world problems with emerging technologies are invoiced throughout the year.

MEX – Music Extension Program

MEX Excellence Program doesn't charge additional fees for the subject.

Instrumental and Vocal Music Program

The following fees apply only to students enrolled in Instrumental Music. There are 16 ensembles consisting of band, percussion and choirs. Membership at more than one ensemble is encouraged.

The cost covers membership to ensembles, music and music folder, bus transport to most events, entry fees to competitions, performance opportunities, and music workshops.

Instrumental and Vocal Music Program apply a \$220.00 fee to students enrolled in Instrumental music.

There is an additional equipment fee cost of \$50.00 for percussion students.

Other Programs

Kenmore SHS run additional programs, some of which incur a cost i.e. **Dance Troupe \$200.00 per year.**

Sporting Activities

Kenmore SHS run sporting activities and events throughout the year. The cost of the bus for carnivals and gala days. All other fees including the affiliation fees are covered in the SRS.

Activities and events include:

Gala Days, Competition Sport, Metropolitan West, Northern Eagles, Swimming Carnival, Athletics Carnival, Cross Country.

Camps/ Excursions/ Incursions & Other Activities



School Camps provide students with opportunities to develop leadership skills, social, physical and intellectual skills, and team building skills. They also help students build self-confidence, independence and relationships. School camps have shown to increase connection to school and peers and increase efficacy. Excursions and incursions allow students to get out of the classroom and explore. They provide another dimension to class-based learning, expose students to new experiences and give students an opportunity to learn about, and see, new things in a less structured environment with different learning styles available.

Camps, excursions and incursions require consent to be provided for students to attend, and payment made by the payment due date. Students who have not paid for the excursion in full will not attend the excursion/camps and alternative arrangements will be made at school.

All costs for the activity will be communicated to parents and payment should be paid a week before the activity.

Refunds for School Camps, Excursions and Incursions

A School fee is directed to the purpose for which it is charged. School fees for excursions, incursions and camps are calculated on a cost recovery only basis, according to the number of students who have indicated their attendance. Participation of students in an excursion or camp is indicated through payment of the excursion or camp fee and provision of a permission form completed by the parent/carer.

As the School budget cannot meet any shortfalls in funding for an excursion or camp due to the subsequent non-participation of a student who had previously indicated attendance of the activity, fees already paid for an excursion or school camp may be refunded in full or in part, or not at all, having regard to the associated expenses incurred and the circumstances of the non-participation.

Fees are calculated as close as possible to the expenses related directly to the excursion/incursion/camp but at times a deficit or surplus of funds can occur. With the support of the School's Parents & Citizens Association, in the event of this occurring where the amount is under \$20.00 per student the funds will be redirected into the program area that the excursion/incursion/camp is linked to e.g., English, Maths etc. When there is a deficit the program area will cover the shortfall from their individual faculty budgets.

If a parent/carer wishes to apply for a refund due to their child's non-participation in an excursion or camp activity prior to the cut-off date for refunds, they may do so by completing a Request for Refund form available from the Payment Desk in the Office.

Where possible, the request should include the receipt relating to the payment for which a refund is being sought. The refund will depend on the associated expenses incurred for the activity. It is preferred that refunds are made as a credit against the student's account at the school and used for any cost in the future.

Kenmore State High School Refund Policy



At Kenmore State High School, we are committed to providing a safe and supportive learning environment for students, staff and volunteers. This commitment includes the health and safety of staff and students when conducting curriculum activities in the school or in other locations.

School excursions and camps enhance a student's learning by providing opportunities for the student to participate in activities, both curriculum-related and recreational, outside the normal school routine. All planned school excursions are approved by the principal and endorsed by the Parents and Citizens' Association.

State schools can charge a fee for:

- An educational service including materials and consumables not defined as instruction, administration and facilities for the education of the student.
- An education service purchased from a provider other than the school where the provider charges the school; and
- A specialised educational program.

A school fee is directed to the purpose for which it is charged. School fees for excursions and camps are calculated on a cost recovery only basis, according to the number of students who have indicated their attendance. Participation of students in an excursion or camp is indicated through payment of the fee and provision of a permission form completed by the parent/carer.

As the school budget cannot meet any shortfalls in funding for an excursion or camp due to the subsequent non-participation of a student who had previously indicated attendance of the activity, fees already paid for an excursion or school camp may be refunded in full, in part, or not at all, having regard to the associated expenses incurred and the circumstances of the non-participation.

If a parent wishes to apply for a refund due to their child's non-participation in an excursion or camp, they may do so by completing a Request for Refund form available from the school office and on the school website. Where possible, the request should include the receipt relating to the payment for which a refund is being sought.

Students who have school fees and or amounts outstanding will have any refund credited to the outstanding account to minimise the debt. Parents with no outstanding debt will have the option of having the refund credited to their students' account for use to offset any future charges or deposited by EFT into the nominated bank account as directed by the parent/caregiver.

When all avenues are exhausted Kenmore State High School will apply to Education Queensland Central Office to assist in the recovery of the debt.

Debt recovery action can be undertaken for outstanding fees and charges. Some examples:

- Tetbook hire and educational resources (including ICT) provided by schools that if not provided by the school would have to be purchased by the parent, for example, photocopies of workbooks
- Materials for subjects where the instruction is extended through providing practical learning experiences additional to materials provided by school grants
- Charges (other than instruction, administration or facilities) that are necessary for the completion of competencies that are part of vocational certificates
- School excursions
- Transport to sporting events
- Swimming levy
- Hire of equipment, for example, musical instruments/photographic equipment
- School Formals/Evenings
- Sporting/artistic programs that extend beyond the core curriculum
- Administration charges relating to setting up work experience and school-based apprenticeships and traineeships
- Reprographics (other than photocopies of workbooks)
- Arts and craft supplies
- Cooking materials
- Parents and Citizens' Association voluntary contributions

If Kenmore State High school has several outstanding accounts, it will go about recovering the money by a process of negotiation with the parent/caregiver. Strategies for recovery include issuing monthly statements, negotiating payment schedules, and telephone or personal contact with the parent/carer to discuss outstanding fees.

Once these avenues have been exhausted, it will be referred to our Debt Recovery Team in Brisbane.

Parent Fee Responsibility

The enrolling parent is the parent responsible for students' school fees. All invoices/statements will be emailed directly to the parent. This is the only parent to see invoices on QParents.

The school does not enter into any private arrangements for payment of school fees between parents. Payments must be made by invoice due date.

Payment Plans

Payments plans are available at KSHS. Please email finance@kenmoreshs.eq.edu.au to request further information.

Payment plans are not available for some programs and activities (including Excellence programs, VET programs, camps, excursions and incursions). Students who are enrolled in these programs commit to a greater financial outlay that covers the cost of outside providers, transport to and from competitions, specialised curriculum resources, training and uniforms.

Financial Hardship

In circumstances of financial hardship, please contact the Finance Manager in the first instance to discuss financial hardship and how the financial obligation can be met throughout the year. This may be to negotiate alternate arrangements such as a Payment Plan, Centrepay or a Financial Plan.

Hardship is defined as circumstances by which payment of a debt would cause significant adverse financial effects on the student and/or family. Onus of proof is on the debtor to provide evidence of being so affected. Students who are at risk of disengaging from learning (e.g. independent students) and students of parents experiencing financial hardship will not be disadvantaged through the imposition of school fees. Kenmore State High School will take this into consideration when determining fee waivers.

The Business Manager will determine the decision-making parameters for waiving fees by considering such things as:

- Genuine financial hardship
- Compassionate grounds
- Value of debt
- Age of debt
- Cost effectiveness and likelihood of making recovery

The decision to waive fees can only be made by the Business Manager or Executive Principal. In instances of a Financial Plan being completed, supporting documentation will be required.

In considering the provided information to substantiate financial hardship, the school will comply with the *Information Privacy Act 2009 (Qld)* and the Information Privacy Principles contained in Schedule 3 of that Act.

Non-Payment of Fees

It is not viable for the school to provide services if fees are outstanding. These services include SRS, Excursions, VET courses, CYOD, Service Guarantee Fee, Specialist and other programs.
