What is VETiS Funding?

Vocational Education and Training in Schools (VETiS) is a federal program that provides funding for students whilst they are in school to complete a Certificate I or II course with a recognised RTO.

Students can receive ONE free Certificate I or II VET course whilst enrolled in school

If studying more than ONE Certificate Course the fees will be out of pocket for the second and any subsequent courses, we recommend using the VETiS for the more expensive course

Certificate III, IV and Diplomas are not eligible for VETiS funding

***Fee for Service is your out-of-pocket expense if VETiS funding is not being allocated to that course enrolment
