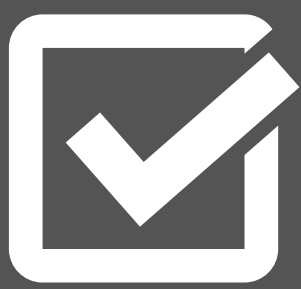

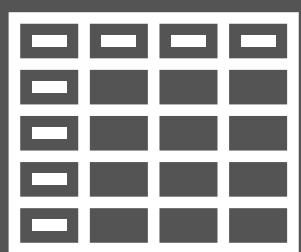
CONTINUOUS LEARNING: DAILY STUDENT GUIDE
